DETAILS OF FIELD TRIPS AND SPECIAL EVENTS FOR THE WEEK

Monday, July 23th Today is the First Day of the 5th Week of the Thirteenth Year of the World Famous STX Big Island Adventure Camp & Country Club HEY! @ AZ

Theme: 2018 = RISE—Resilient, Inspiring, Soar & Envision

Tuesday, July 24th

3/4 yr olds: Northside Valley and Playground Picnic—we will head to Northside Valley for an environmental project, and then picnic and play at the playground in Frederiksted!

65/6 yr olds: Bowling—We will travel to our local bowling alley! There campers will enjoy several games of bowling with their camp friends and CIT's—**SOCKS ARE A MUST!!!** We will return back to camp for lunch and afternoon activities.

Wednesday, July 25th

9/10 yr olds: Jeep Tour—A camp favorite. Campers will load up in Tan Tan jeeps and travel all over the island. Great way to learn about the history of STX, experience it's beauty and have a blast! **Supplies Needed:** Sneakers, beach attire, sunscreen, towel, water bottle and a bag lunch.

11-13 yr olds: Farm Pods—This is the farming technique of the future! Farm pods are vertical, hydroponic growing containers that produce a high volume of yield, using very little space, and driven by technology that runs it all. We are excited to share this agricultural advancement with our campers!

Thursday, July 26th

11-13 yr olds: Buck Island -We will taxi to the board walk. There we will board a boat that will take us over to the famous Buck Island. There we will snorkel, hike and enjoy beach fun. **Supplies Needed:** Bag lunch and water. Sunscreens, a sun shirt, cover up and/or hats are highly recommended! Don't miss this trip, it's a camp favorite! We will return to campus for a cool off swim. Additional Waiver Needed!

6-13 yr olds: Turtle Watch : (limited to 25 including parents & staff) - for those who pre-order pizza dinner, online, it is served @ 3:45pm before departing to Sandy Point in Frederiksted. Departure from AZ at 4:15 SHARP! We will travel in a taxi van to Sandy Point, where the Wildlife & Fisheries team will guide us to the beach where we will explore the beaches for turtle nests which are emerging. There have been trips where we have found up to 90 baby leatherbacks. Once they emerge out of the nest, we will then release them into the sea. **3 different pick up locations: 1** - The end of the Highway in Frederiksted, **2** - Home Depot Parking Lot & **3** - AZ Academy campus. If parents are running late for the first 2 locations, they will have to pick up their camper at AZ. We will NOT hang around at the first 2 locations. Estimated arrival at AZ is 8:00pmish. Space is limited, parents are allowed to join us if room is available, but campers come first. **No cameras are allowed!**

8:30 am: Opening Celebration—Crowning Week 6 Campers of the Week. Please get to camp on time!!

7&8 yr olds: Soul Kallaloo Cruzan Style - We are on a mission to impact STX/ the world by awakening all to what's really important. PM PICK UP: If an older camper has a sibling or car rider camper in a younger age group then he/she is expected to be picked up with this group. **All groups** will be picked up as you enter AZ's property new 1st stairwell. **PLEASE STAY IN YOUR CAR!**

CONCESSION: The concession stand is open from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. Items vary in cost from \$. 25 to \$3.00 **Computerized Concession Accounts:** Mandatory for all 4 yr olds thru 10 yr olds. It is the easiest way to keep track and not lose money.

LUNCH: The Federal Lunch Program is in full swing

Camper's must bring a Bag LUNCH or a Pre-Ordered Lunch with us and water on all field trips.

Cost: Pre ordered Lunch \$25/Week or \$8/Day

The Field Trip Lunches - Camper's must bring a BAG LUNCH for day long field trips! If they don't bring a lunch on field trips one will be provided and your account will be charged. (\$8 per daily lunch)

IMMUNIZATION RECORDS: Per the DHS, all camper's must have on file a current immunization record in order to attend camp. Camper's will not be allowed to start the first day of camp without these on file!! **LIABILITY WAIVERS are completed through the registration process!**

NUTS AND BOLTS OF CAMP

CAMP T-SHIRTS: For **safety reasons** and easy identification, camper's, CIT's & Staff members are expected to wear his/her camp T-shirt **every day**.

SHOES: Camper's are asked to wear sneakers (not sandals/slippers) due to outdoor games and activities. Please remember this is camp. Please do not dress your camper in his/her best sneakers or shorts. They may get lost, torn or stained.

Please, Please! NO Cell Phones, Jewelry, Electronics, Games or Toys!!!! Camper's are allowed to use camp phones, just ask. We are not responsible for any lost, stolen or misplaced items.

EVERY DAY each camper should have a tote bag for a swimming suit (No cut offs), towel, water bottle, sunscreen and a hat.

PLEASE CLEARLY MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CAMPER'S NAME!

CAMP AFTERCARE: Location: After closing ceremonies and traffic from car riders has cleared, aftercare camper's will be escorted from the mahogany stage/car riders to the AZ upper campus.

Aftercare Camper's: Aftercare closes at 5:30 p.m. sharp! Please be on time! A \$20.00 late fee will be charged per camper each time a camper is picked up late. Please call if you are running late. (340-244-7035). **Aftercare Pick Up:** All aftercare camper's must be signed out by the person picking up your camper. If it is not a parent or guardian picking up your camper, please call the office to let us know!

MAGIC ENVELOPE: It is **EASY & Efficient!!** Mark with your camper name, purpose, and give it to our before care camp staff or your camper's group leader. There is a procedure in place for all staff members to accept money, notes, etc! All necessary newsletters, forms, and permission slips can be found and downloaded from www.azvi.org.
